# ONLINE REGISTRATION

# **HOW TO REGISTER ONLINE**

1. LOG ON TO WWW.KISSIMMEE.GOV, select "Parks & Recreation" under "Departments," and then select "Register Online." Enter your username and password.

If you have EVER registered for a class, rented a facility, or purchased a pass/membership, you are already in our system. This means that even if you have never used WebTrac, you may already have an account.

For example, if you have registered for a class at a Community Center & have paid a deposit, you already have an account that you can access through WebTrac. PLEASE DO NOT CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT ON WEBTRAC UNLESS YOU HAVE NEVER REGISTERED AT A PARKS & RECREATION FACILITY OR ONLINE BEFORE.

- The first time you log in to WebTrac, your default Username and Password are listed below:
- Username: Enter the email address we have on file . Password: Enter your home Zip Code
- If you do not know your password, you can reset it using your email address by selecting "Forgot Password." If
- you have any other issues logging in, please call the Parks & Recreation Administration line at 407.518.2501
- Once logged in, you will then be prompted to update your account information & change username & password

#### 2. SELECT A PROGRAM

• Browse programs by **Category** (Preschool, Youth, etc.) and/or by **Type** (Sports, Music, etc.) OR by **Keyword** (ex. Tennis) or by using the **Activity Number** of a specific program listed in this Guide (Ex. 120107).

#### 3. REGISTER

- Click on the plus sign to the left of the program under "Add."
- Select the family member to enroll.
- Click the "continue" button.

#### 4. CHECKOUT

- Once added to your cart, you can either continue to the payment screen or the "Shopping Cart" at the top page
- Follow the prompts to checkout Please note that we can only accept Visa or Mastercard payments.
- · Review the billing information and follow the prompts to complete payment.

#### **ENROLLMENT POLICY**

Every program session has a minimum and maximum enrollment to ensure a quality experience. The best way to check availability and confirm enrollment is to register online at www.webtrac.kissimmee.gov or by phone/in person at the pertinent facility.

#### **INSURANCE/WAIVER & RELEASE FORMS**

There is an inherent risk when participating in certain recreational activities, The Parks & Recreation Department does not carry medical accident insurance for injuries or illnesses sustained by its programs. Prior to participating, all persons must sign a waiver and release form. Online registrants will also be required to agree to the "terms" as part of the checkout process. The absence of personal medical insurance coverage does not make the City of Kissimmee responsible for the payment of a participant's medical expenses.

#### **LATE FEE POLICY**

All programs and/or camps may be subject to late fees as determined by the Parks & Recreation Department or program instructors.

#### **PROGRAM CANCELLATIONS**

Activity fees must be paid in full by the time of the program registration. The Parks & Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel or combine programs and/or change the time, date(s), instructor, or location of a program or activity, if necessary. In the event that your program is changed or canceled, you will be notified and will be issued a complete refund if you do not find a comparable program.

#### **PROGRAM REFUNDS**

If you choose to cancel your registration, a refund request may be issued based on approval and the following scale:

- 100% refund on or before first day(s)/week of class
- 75% refund on or before second day(s)/week of class
- 0% refund after second day(s)/week of class\*

\*After the second day(s)/week of class, a doctors note will be required to be issued a prorated refund.




