**CITY REQUIREMENTS**

\*FLOATS - Each parade float must have a fire extinguisher with a minimum 2A-10BC rating. The fire extinguisher must have a current tag issued by a State of Florida licensed fire extinguisher contractor. NO OPEN FLAMES are allowed on any floats or vehicles.

\*HORSES - Proof of negative Coggins test result must be provided for all horses participating in the parade. Entries with horses must have designated individuals to pick up any excrement.

\*CHILDREN - Children under 12 years old must have parental supervision in the parade, at ALL times.

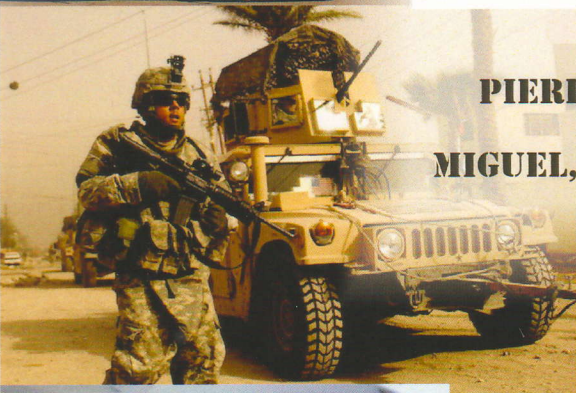
