## APPLICATION FOR AFTER MIDNIGHT ALCOHOL SALES PERMIT

Pursuant to City of Kissimmee Code section 4-9, any restaurant, microbrewery, distillery, tasting room, or specialty retail establishment within the Downtown Community Redevelopment Area (hereinafter "Establishment"), which desires to remain open for the purpose of the sale, service, or consumption of alcoholic beverages on premise between the hours of Midnight and 2:00 AM, may make an application with the City for an After Midnight Alcohol Sales Permit (hereinafter "Permit"). Please note that the Permit does not apply to package sale vendors. No Permit may be issued to an Establishment that has any outstanding obligations to the City, including but not limited to any code violations or liens.

### PERMIT POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

**No Right to Permit:** The ability to sell intoxicating liquor for consumption on premises or package sale is a privilege subject to modification, suspension, or termination by the City. Therefore, no Establishment has a right to a Permit.

**Extended Hours:** An Establishment must obtain a Permit to remain open for the purpose of the sale, service, or consumption of alcoholic beverages between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 2:00 a.m. An Establishment may continue to remain open and sell, serve, or permit to be served or consumed, alcohol between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 12:00 a.m. with or without a Permit. An Establishment will be construed open for business if any person, other than an employee or person with an ownership interest, is inside the business after the closing hour designated in City of Kissimmee Code section 4-3.

**Permit Application Fee:** The Business must pay an administrative fee of \$250 at the Kissimmee Police Department Lobby upon submission of this Application and to apply for any renewals of this Permit.

**Duty to Keep Permit Application Up to Date:** The Business has a continuing obligation to update the information contained on this Application within ten (10) days after any change in the information set forth on this Application. Failure to amend this Application to reflect any updated information, may result in termination of the Business's Permit.

**Review:** The Chief, or their designee, shall review the Application and determine whether to issue a Permit.

**Permit Effective Term:** The Permit shall be valid for a 12-month term provided that the Business maintains a valid business tax receipt and continues to operate at the physical location listed on the Application and provided that the Permit is not suspended or revoked by the Chief of Police (for more information, please see City of Kissimmee Code s. 4-9(g) and (h) for more information).

**Inspections:** By accepting and operating pursuant to a Permit, the Business expressly approves, permits, and authorizes any law enforcement or code enforcement officer to enter the Business, when such the Business is open, and conduct a search to determine whether any provisions of law, including City Code section 4-9, are being violated. "Open" shall mean any time members of the public are inside the Business, whether or not they have paid a fee to enter, or whether or not their presence is pursuant to a private event. It is unlawful for an Establishment operating pursuant to a Permit to refuse to allow an inspection of as described herein at any time the Permitted Establishment is open.
